


We also **offer a range of services** such as catering and floristry services, arranging workshops, local activities and gifts, and much more.





Corporate Spaces


Below are the floor plans of The Barns (excluding the mezzanine floor with 6 extra beds), highlighting some of the areas that may be useful when you stay with us.



GROUND FLOOR

Our First Floor has a designated meeting/presentation space, with plenty of room to sit and discuss ideas. We have a TV screen, presentation boards with board markers, and comfortable seating. We have some recommended seating layouts that we can set up before you arrive.

We provide teas and coffees and a bottle of water per delegate, and can add on snacks/refreshments if required.

10:00am - Meeting Session 2





– In the Kitchens, we provide: -

These need to be booked in advance of your stay and incur an additional charge. They are subject to availability.

Byre Kitchen Aga (2nd/3rd kitchen when booking Old Mill, Hayloft & Byre or Exclusive Use): priced at £300/weekend, or £450 for 7 nights.

Byre Hot Tub (2nd/3rd hot tub when booking Exclusive Use), priced at £250 for 3 nights, £450 for 7 nights.

Z-Beds - £75 each

Daily Newspapers- price dependent on publication and number required, + £2.00 delivery charge.

Bed Linen Changes – We replace and change all bed linen, robes and slippers, spa and bath towels. Charge is £16 single, £24 king sized.

Bedroom/Bathroom clean and linen change - £24 per room plus linen charge

Barn Fairies to help with cleaning, childcare, or to serve food & drinks if required. Ask for more detailed information.

Pets – dogs are most welcome here, priced at £50 per pet per stay.

Pack & Run Service – priced from £80 in The Stables & Granary, £120 for The Mill, and £160 for Exclusive Hire: Leave the cleaning and just pack and go.

Gas BBQs (available May to September) £40 charge includes gas and us cleaning it for you

Fresh Flowers on Arrival - from a local florist, priced from $\pounds 40$

We will contact you near the time of your stay where we will offer the option to book these extra services.





Barn Fairies

The Barn Fairies can be available for all types of assistance with your stay.

They will endeavour to make the stay stress-free, seamless and ensure you and your guests are having a fabulous time.

Their duties include, but are not limited to:

- Waitressing, hosting and general serving, clearing up during an event: £20 per hour minimum of 3 hours
- Mid-week cleans on a room-by-room basis or whole barn clean: £30 per room, excluding kitchens which are £100
- Pack & Run Service guests can just pack their belongings and leave the cleaning to our fairies: £80 for Stables & Granary, £120 for Mill, Hayloft & Byre and £160 for Exclusive Hire.
- Babysitting Duties: The Barn Fairies can offer a day or evening service; price to be discussed depending on situation.

Please note that all services above must be organised and booked prior to stay.

Noise Policy

We should make you aware that we have new neighbours in a luxury development of properties on the opposite side of the road, so therefore due to the proximity of our neighbours we have implemented a noise policy, there is to be **no amplified music and any music played outdoors must**be within daylight hours and no later than 9.00pm. Any music played indoors must be with doors and windows closed and turned off at 11.00pm at the latest.

Included in the stay are Bose and Sonos speakers for our guests to use, we do however ask for them to be used responsibly and ask that our guests be mindful of our neighbours and only play music at a reasonable level. Please also note that the **hot tubs are closed between 9.00pm and 10.00am daily.**

Please circulate this noise policy with all of your guests; we reserve the right to charge a call out fee if we receive any complaints.

Accessibility at The Barns

The properties that coin The Barns were once a busy cattle barn. Although this has lead to some unique features, it does create uneven floors through the barns, which poses the need for steps throughout. We have made some changes to make the spaces more accessible to all.

Within The Old Mill we have implemented:

- 1. Step-Free Entrance: Purpose-designed ramps throughout the property to allow smooth movement throughout the ground floor.
- 2. Ground Floor Bedrooms: Clear space around the room and bed to manoeuvre wheelchairs with disabled access to the bathroom.
- 3. Accessible Bathrooms: Roll-in curbless shower with grab rails, shower chairs and grab bars near the toilet.
- 4. Accessible Outdoor Space: Courtyard with paved areas surrounding it, and a smooth ramp leading into it with accessible garden seating.
- 5. Parking: Dedicated parking spaces close to the entrance.

Throughout all barns we have implemented:

- 1. Wide doorways: to be able to fit wheelchairs through.
- 2. Accessible kitchen: lower cabinets where appliances are located and large handles on the doors.
- 3. Level flooring: no raised thresholds or trip hazards such as large thick rugs.
- 4. Clear printed instructions: all appliance instructions are printed in large clear text.

Please let us know if there are any accommodations we can make to make your stay as comfortable as possible.

Sustainability at The Barns

At The Barns, we are committed to promoting sustainability and minimizing our impact on the environment. We recognise the importance of preserving natural resources for future generations and strive to reduce our carbon footprint through environmentally responsible practices. By implementing these sustainability practices, we aim to create positive environmental impact while enhancing the experience of our guests. We appreciate the support of our guests in helping us protect the planet and preserve the natural beauty of the Herefordshire countryside we are surrounded by.

Here are some of the steps we take to ensure that our operations are eco-friendly and sustainable:

Energy Conservation:

Renewable Energy: We prioritise the use of renewable energy where possible such as solar panel and green energy tariffs.

Energy Efficient: All lighting in our accommodation uses energy efficient LED bulbs. Appliances provided are energy rated to ensure minimal energy consumption.

Heating and Cooling: Our heating and cooling systems are set to operate at optimal efficiency.

Thermostats are programmed to reduce energy consumption when the accommodation is unoccupied. Guests are encouraged to be mindful of energy use by turning off lights, heating and cooling when not needed.

Water Consumption:

Recycling Programme: We provide clearly labelled recycling bins for paper, glass, plastic and metal. Guests are encouraged to sort their waste accordingly.

Waste Minimisation: We actively reduce single-use plastics and encourage guests to use reuseable items.

Water Minimisation: We encourage guests to use Eco modes when using the Dishwasher and Washing Machine.

Eco-Friendly Products:

Green Cleaning Products: We use eco-friendly, biodegradable cleaning products for all cleaning and maintenance tasks.

Sustainable Toiletries: We provide eco-friendly, refillable handwash and toilet paper sourced from sustainable suppliers.

Local and Organic Produce: Where possible we source organic and local food products for guest welcome hampers and encourage guests to support local suppliers.

Biodiversity and Landscaping:

Native Planting: Our garden features native plants that are well-suited to the local climate and require minimal watering and maintenance. This helps promote local biodiversity and reduces water usage.

Support Local Initiatives: We collaborate with local environmental organisations and encourage guests to participate in eco-friendly activities such as tree planting or litter picking in the local area.

Continuous Improvement:

Monitoring and Evaluation: We regularly monitor our energy, water, and waste management to identify opportunities for improvement. We set goals for reducing our environmental impact and review our sustainability practices annually.
